ROAD COMMISSION: Debbi approved the Brine Application for the three holidays this year. A solid application is 50/50 split with the Road Commission. As of March 31, 2023, the cost was \$.26 per gallon. This may change due to EGLE brine restrictions. Both the cost per gallon and the brine application process may change.
